









#### Introduction

## Why is the CCDO Scheme going SMART?

Demolition / Construction Site Managers request that workers hold the relevant CCDO card before being allowed access to site to carry out demolition related activities.

### The CCDO scheme's use of Smart Cards aims to provide the following benefits:

- Adopting Smart Cards will help improve health and safety on site by ensuring that operatives have the appropriate experience, skills and qualifications to carry out the role they are employed to do, whilst at the same time help to reduce and eliminate the possibility of fraudulent cards being used to access sites.
- Smart Card use greatly simplifies and speeds up the task of checking cards required of site managers at the point of access to site by means of a simple and easy to use App via a smartphone, tablet or a card reader attached to a PC/Laptop.
- If you are a self-employed operative, you can use the CCDO Smart Card to keep training records and certifications up to date.

All CCDO scheme Smart Cards are affiliated to the pan-industry Construction Skills Certification Scheme (CSCS) and carry the affiliation logo accordingly, therefore eliminating the requirement for separate or additional CSCS registration.

### **Demolition Site Visitor Card**

5 year - Yellow Card

#### **Supervised Duties:**

The Demolition Site Visitor card is intended for those individuals with no specific demolition skills or functions, but nonetheless need to visit demolition sites e.g. Plant Fitters and Safety Auditors.

#### **Demolition Site Visitor Card**

This card **excludes** demolition related activities

Current Emergency First Aid certificate (recommended option)

### **Demolition Labourer Card**

5 year - Green Card

#### **Supervised Duties:**

■ General labouring duties under supervision, as directed by a Chargehand or above.

Current approved Asbestos Awareness certificate – NOT E-Learning

### **Demolition Apprentice Card**

2 year - Red Card (Under Supervision)

#### **Apprentice Route Duties:**

Card issued at the start of an approved training course programme, valid for two years with the Demolition & Refurbishment Operative card issued on successful completion. A level 2 NVQ is included within the course.

#### **Demolition Apprentice Card**

Must have held a Demolition Labourer Card for a minimum of 3 months **Current Demolition Specialist or above** Health, Safety and Environment Test Pass Registered for the approved **Apprenticeship Course** This card is NON-RENEWABLE all apprentice 'RED' cards require a level 2 NVQ **Application Form** 



# Trained Operative Demolition and Refurbishment Operative Card

3 year - Red Card (Under Supervision)

#### **Supervised Duties:**

- Mobile work tools.
- Non-structural hot works.
- Segregate materials for recycling.

Must hold a Demolition Labourer Card and/ or have 2 years Demolition Industry experience

Current Demolition Specialist or above Health, Safety and Environment Test Pass

Current approved Asbestos Awareness certificate – NOT E-Learning

#### THE NDTG GOES VIRTUAL

First in the construction industry to market their Virtual CCDO Smart Card, the NDTG are set to issue over 1,000 virtual cards by the end of 2018

#### What is a virtual card?

New applicants have the choice of being issued with a Virtual CCDO Smart Card in addition to a physical CCDO Smart Card. The virtual card works by way of an application downloaded to the card holder's smartphone saving the need to carry cards on site.


All of the Demolition operatives relevant qualifications can now be stored on the Vircarda App. The virtual card can simply be scanned and read by the Supervisor on the same Go Smart software used for reading a physical card.

"We are delighted to be the first to launch the eagerly awaited Virtual CCDO Smart Card, proving that the demolition industry remains ahead of the construction industry in terms of technology. The Virtual Smart Card gives workers and supervisors immediate access to information, reducing both the need to carry a physical card and the possibility of fraud. Furthermore, the app will work on Apple devices, which is a big plus."
